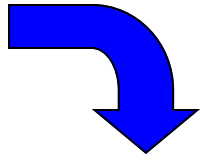

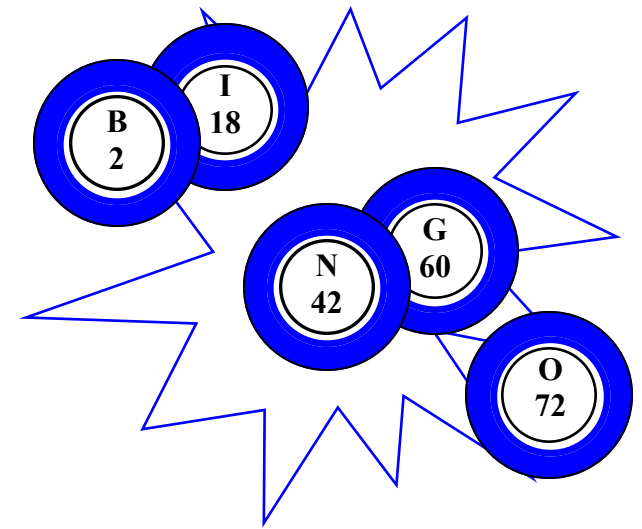
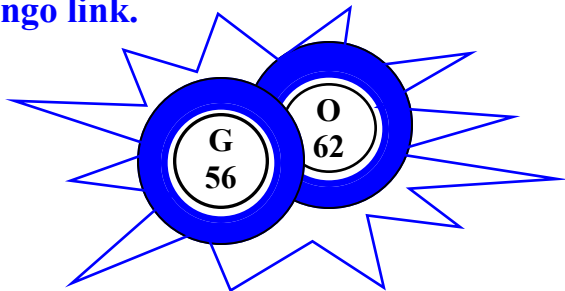

You can be credited as little or as much as you need to help pay a students tuition only at St. Peter.

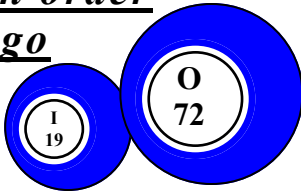
Whose Your Student?

5:00 p.m.—10:00 p.m. OR 6:00 p.m.—10:00 p.m.

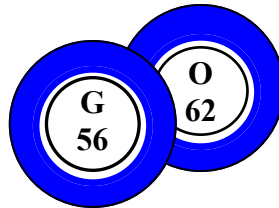
*Amount of Tuition Credit that can be credited and applied depends on hours worked. **

Example:

*If you work 5:00 p.m. —10:00 p.m.,
you can be credited \$30.00*

*If you work 6:00 p.m.—10:00 p.m.,
you can be credited \$25.00*

You can also “Pay-It-Forward” (collect credit to go towards next years tuition.)



*** If you have a previous tuition balance, this credit will be applied to the past due balance.**

HISTORY

In October 1977, with the approval of Father Victor Ries, Bingo began at St. Peters. Bingo began at St. Peters in the hope raising monies to help pay off the church debt, making repairs to existing buildings and to help with the upkeep of the buildings.
